

DATA PROTECTION INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS

Dear Patient,

The protection of your personal data is important to us. In accordance with to the EU Data Protection Ordinance (DSGVO), we are obliged to inform you about the purpose for which our practice collects stores or passes on data. This fact sheet also provides information concerning your rights with regard to data protection.

1. RESPONSIBILITY FOR DATA PROCESSING

2. PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING

Data processing is conducted in accordance with statutory requirements in order to fulfil the treatment contract between you and your doctor, and its associated obligations.

We process your personal data for this purpose, in particular your medical data. This data include anamneses, diagnoses, recommended therapies and findings from this practice or from other doctors. Other doctors or psychotherapists with whom you are under treatment may also provide us with data for these purposes (e.g. in doctor's letters).

The collection of medical data is a prerequisite for your treatment. If the necessary information is not provided, you cannot be treated with due care.

3. RECIPIENTS OF YOUR DATA

We will only pass your personal data on to third parties when it is legally permissible to do so, or if you have given your consent. The recipients of your personal data may include other doctors or psychotherapists, associations of statutory health insurance physicians, health insurance companies, the medical staff of health insurance companies, medical associations and private medical clearing offices.

The data is mainly passed on for the purpose of invoicing the services that you have received, and to clarify questions relating to your health or your insurance cover. In individual cases, data may be passed on to other authorised recipients.

4. DATA STORAGE

We will only store your personal data for as long as is necessary to carry out treatment. Due to statutory regulations, we are obliged to store this data for at least 10 years after treatment is completed. Other regulations may stipulate longer storage periods in some cases: e.g., 30 years for X-ray images, in accordance with Section 28, para. 3 of the X-ray Ordinance.

5. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to obtain information about your personal data. You can also request the correction of incorrect data.

Under certain conditions, you also have the right to have your data deleted, the right to restrict data processing and the right to data portability.

Your data will be processed on the basis of statutory regulations. We only need your consent in exceptional circumstances. In such cases, you have the right to revoke your consent for future processing.

You also have the right to register a complaint with the competent supervisory authority for data protection if you believe that the processing of your personal data is unlawful.
